July 4th 2019 was the 46th death Anniversary of our dear Mother Anna Huberta. As I am reflecting I see on her face, a special smile which radiates God's love. Her walk itself reflected the determination she had, a person ready to set the world on fire of God's love. Her intimacy with God was her power to reach out to the hundreds of children. Her deep union with Jesus is how she spoke to the friends in Germany on the feast of Corpus Christi. "The hymn of God's love must be sung! God wants to put his own love into our hearts. This must be lived in us and for this reason He became the bread that we eat, this bread in order that He lives in us and that we learn to give up ourselves in love."

As a young Mary I used to admire Mother Anna Huberta. When she returns to her place after receiving the Holy Communion, it seemed that she met her God of heaven and earth. Such was her graceful way of life that she lived and told us "You have no foundress but the Holy Spirit is your founder." She would often remind us when we were novices "You neither be cold nor hot I will spew you out of my mouth" Rev.3:15 what she meant was that we shouldn't do things half heartedly. As she herself was full of life, zeal and filled with the Spirit. Late Fr. Joseph Neuner, S.J. who was closely associated with the Mother writes about her in his book, 'Mother Anna Huberta and her Personality' as she expressed "I wanted to serve only the one, with all my faculties, with my whole person". Often she had expressed this great love in her own youthful manner the love which filled her whole heart. She experienced it in singing them and she asked herself: "How is it that I was so fond of those tunes of love?" She knew the answer: "In all those song I meant only the ONE". Only one love captivated her mind, the love of God, the love of Jesus. To Him she devoted her entire life. His love for the people, for the poor, became the great love of her life which is well expressed in a prayer which Mother Anna Huberta always carried with her.

"My flowers blossom before you, My songs sings for you, My hands work for you, My feet walk for you, In your mercy and love I kneel, That you take me and fill me, My hands and my feet, That I know only you beyond all"

This shows the depth of her holiness, she was indeed rooted in God's love. That is how our pioneer sisters were inspired and said Mother we want to "LIVE FOR LOVE" they signed with their blood, later on it became the motto of the Society of the Helpers of Mary. Mother, we your daughters ask your blessings thus we may be able to live our motto in the best possible way and fulfil your vision and mission to the poor and the needy

On admission her BP was 170/110 mmhg and her Haemoglobin was 8.5gm%. After a month treatment her Haemoglobin came up to 10gm%, and blood pressure came to Normal and her sonography also showed good

In the year 2014 I completed my 10th class (S.S.C) with 70.40%. I continued junior college in the Commerce stream and successfully completed same scoring 70.62%. I had a great desire to do my graduation, so I expressed this wish to Sr. Bridget and she granted my wish by giving me permission to continue my graduation in B.A.F (Bachelor of Accounting and Finance) from Bal Bhavan. In return I helped the sisters in caring for the little children, helped them with their home works, project work, taught them dances, made them practice singing etc. I have successfully completed my graduation with A grade. Presently I am working in a bank and earning Rs. 15,000/-

I am very grateful to all the sisters, teachers and friends for giving me various opportunities to update my knowledge and giving me a comfortable life which I lived here in Bal Bhavan for last sixteen years. Living in care homes, the children are more prone to behavioural and emotional problems than others as they are deprived of family's love and care. Becoming aware of these situations of the children's problem the Provincial team decided to conduct a seminar for children in different age groups. Thus we organized a two days seminar for each group (three groups) in Ma-Niketan, Thane. The main thrust of the seminar was how to concentrate, focus and change of mind set.

All of us carry with us the joy, innocence of our childhood as well as disappointments, past hurt and unmet emotional needs. We have noticed that some of the children disconnect from self and look for more attention for unmet emotional needs like safety,

attention, appreciation, to be heard and valued. The amazing resource person Mr. Sachin Kamble and his team conducted this session through meaningful and thought provoking games, dances, drawing, sharing. The mind-blowing performances and creative activities opened up the minds and heart of all the children. 274 children from our different children's homes participated in this seminar with a resolution for empowerment as a first little step. With simple method they taught them to transform their painful memories and worked out issues like anger, stress, resentment, grief, fear, self esteem problems and other behaviour or negative belief patterns.
